# MUNICIPAL PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NO. 2, 2025

Municipal Plan and Development Regulations Amendments No. 2, 2025 concern the development of aerospace industries in response to a proposal by Nordspace for the development of a spaceport in the community. Council adopted the Amendments on April 1, and a Public Hearing was scheduled to take place April 21. There being no objections or representations in response to the Town's Notice of Public Hearing, the Hearing was cancelled.

Under Section 23 of the Act, the Town may now consider the amendments for Approval.

Be it resolved that Municipal Plan Amendment No. 2, 2025 which adds Aerospace Industry as a discretionary use to the Rural policies of the Plan in Section 3.7 Rural, under the subheading Discretionary Uses on page 22, **be approved as adopted.** 

And furthermore,

Be it resolved that the corresponding Development Regulations Amendment No. 2, 2025 that

- 1. Adds a definition of Spaceport to Schedule A of the Development Regulations.
- 2. Adds Spaceport as a Discretionary use in the Rural Use Zone; and
- 3. Adds Conditions to the Rural Land Use Zone that allows aerospace uses such as spaceports, subject to approval from Transport Canada, conformity with requirements under the Provincial Environmental Assessment Act, and submission of a communications plan that provides details on how the public will be notified of launch activity to ensure public safety as a priority.
